ORDER:

In the reference third read above, Government issued orders for enhancement of scale of assistance on certain items over and above the norms fixed under SDRF/NDRF in the reference 2nd read above exclusively for the TITLI CYCLONE affected people in the affected districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram and Visakhapatnam.

2. In the reference 4th, 5th and 6th read above, the District Collector, Srikakulam/Principal Secretary to Government, AHDD&F / Commissioner of Horticulture, Andhra Pradesh have submitted proposals for issue of further orders on the Hon'ble Chief Minister's decisions dated. 16.10.2018, 17-10-2018 and 18-10-2018 in Srikakulam District for further enhancement of relief and financial assistance to TITLI cyclone affected persons. Accordingly a comprehensive scale of assistance applicable **only to TITLI Cyclone** affected areas/persons is hereby ordered in supersession of orders issued vide G.O.MS.NO.13, Revenue (DM.I) Department, dated.15-10-2018.

1. Gratuitous relief : Rs.5.00 lakh for each death case.

2. Essential Commodities :

- i) 25 Kgs Rice, 1 kg Dall, 1 ltr Palmolein Oil, 1 Kg Potato, 1Kg Onion, ½ kg Sugar per family. In case of Fishermen, it will be 50 Kg rice apart from other commodities. [This assistance is also applicable for the Vamsadhara flood affected persons].
- ii) Issuance of Essential Commodities to all Pink Ration Card holders of cyclone/flood affected areas and also to those persons who are otherwise eligible, applied for but not issued ration cards.

3. Agriculture: Paddy Crop damage: Rs.20,000/- per Ha. Other Agriculture Crops as per the SDRF Norms.

4. Horticulture Crop damages:

- i. Banana : Rs.30,000 per Ha.
- ii. Cashew : Rs.30,000/- Ha.
- iii. Mango : Rs.30,000/- per Ha
- iv. Coconut : Rs.1500/- per tree

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- v. Toddy Trees : Payment of Rs.800/- per fallen toddy tree each.
- vi. Re-plantation of Coconut, Cashewnut & Mango:-
 - (a) Small and Marginal Farmers - Rs.40,000/- per ha for re- plantation in 3 years time under MGNREGS.
 - (b) In case of big farmers, for both cashew and coconut, subsidy available under Government of India schemes and remaining will be borne by the State Government for total assistance of Rs. 40,000/- per ha in 3 years.
- vii. Removal of all fallen Coconut and Cashew trees from the farmer's field will be taken up by the SDRF/fire services department at free of cost. The wage component will be dovetailed from MGNRES.

5. FISHERIES :

- i) Fully damaged/lost FRP motorised boats: Rs.1.00 lakh compensation.
- ii) Fully damaged/lost mechanised boats: Rs. 6.00 lakh.
- iii) Loss of fishing nets : Rs 10,000/-
- iv) Revival of Fishing activities by fishermen- 50% subsidy on purchase of Nets and Boats amounting up to total value of Rs. 3.00 lakh.
- v) Input assistance for Aquaculture-Rs.30,000/- per Ha for loss of aquaculture.

6. ANIMAL HUSBANDRY :

- (i) For death and permanent disability of milch Buffalo and cows Rs.30,000/- (permanent disability to be certified by veterinary doctor).
- (ii) For death of Goats and Sheep Rs.3000/- per animal.
- (iii) For damage of cattle shed Rs.10,000/-
- (iv) Construction of new cattle shed under MGNREGS for SF/MF (Gokulam)- Rs.1.00 lakh for 2 animals, Rs 1.5 lakh for 4 animals & Rs 1.8 Lakh for 6 Animals.

POULTRY SECTOR :

- i) Compensation for Bird loss(As per G.O.Ms.No.9, Revenue (DM.I) Department ,dated.12-10-2014) which is as below.
 - (a) Layers : Rs.150/- for bird
 - (b) Broilers: Rs.75/- for bird

Subject to maximum ceiling (all inclusive) of Rs.15.00 lakhs for Layers and Rs.7.50 lakhs for Broilers. The integrator (Broiler) is treated as One individual farmer and he will be eligible for maximum ceiling amount of Rs.7.50 lakhs.

- ii) Construction of Poultry sheds in integration system only Rs.10,000/- per shed, subject to maximum of three sheds Rs.30,000/-.

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7. HOUSING :

- (i) Rs.10,000/- for damaged houses.
- (ii) Sanction of NTR Housing unit with a cost of Rs.2.5 Lakh against fully damaged houses, to all categories of cyclone/flood victims treating it as a "special case " even if they are covered under earlier housing schemes.
- (iii) A.C/G.I roofing sheets- Free of cost- maximum of 10 sheets per house.

8. Petty shops: For fully damaged petty shops- Rs 10,000/-.

3. In respect of other Industries / rice mills which have been damaged due to cyclone modalities for compensation should be communicated separately.

4. Items not mentioned in this G.O. will be covered under G.Os in vogue.

5. All the Heads of the Departments and the District Collector, Srikakulam, Vizianagaram and Visakhapatnam are requested to send necessary proposals to the Government for release of budget.
