



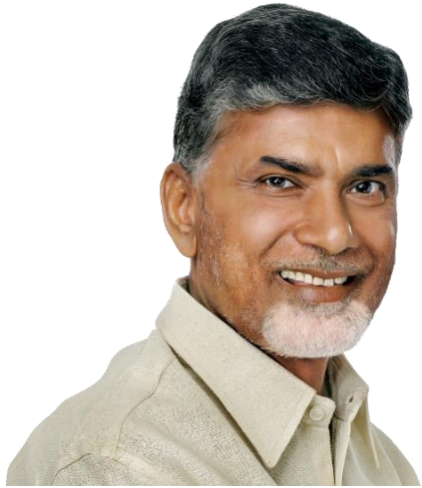

Housing:

- 🌀 **Rs 10,000** for damaged Houses
- 🌀 Assistance for new construction:
 - 🌀 **Rs 1.50 Lakhs** for General
 - 🌀 **Rs 2 Lakhs** for SC
 - 🌀 **Rs 2.25 Lakhs** for ST
- 🌀 A.C Roofing sheets – **Free of Cost**
(Minimum 10 Sheets/House)

Essential commodities distribution

- ❖ Rice – **50Kgs** for **Fishermen families**
& **25 Kgs** for **BPL families**
- ❖ Sugar – **½ Kgs**
- ❖ Oil – **1 liter**
- ❖ Dal – **1 Kg**
- ❖ Onion – **1 Kg**
- ❖ Potato – **1 Kg**

Compensation to Fully Damaged shops: **Rs. 10,000/-**

Relief Package

Scale of Finance - 2

*As per G.O. MS. NO.13 Revenue (DM) Dept.

Agriculture:

- Rs. 20,000/- per Ha for Paddy
- Other Crops as per SDRF Norms.

Horticulture:

- Rs. 20,000/- per Ha for Banana damage.
- Rs. 1,200/- per Coconut tree
- Rs. 25,000/- per Ha for Cashew damage
- Re-plantation of Coconut and Cashew in 3 years time
 - Small and Marginal Farmers – Rs. 40,000/- per Ha
 - Big Farmers – Rs 40,000/- per Ha

Animal Husbandry:

- Rs. 30,000/- for death and permanent disability of Buffaloes and Cows
- Rs. 3,000/- per Goats & Sheep death
- Rs. 10,000/- for damage of Cattle Shed
- Construction of New Cattle shed:
 - Rs. 1,00,000/- for 2 Animals
 - Rs 1,50,000/- for 3 Animals
 - Rs. 2,00,000/- for 4 Animals

Restoration Works

- ✓ **100%** Traffic interruption cleared
- ✓ **94.56%** Power disruptions restored in Srikakulam affected villages
- ✓ **92.49%** Power disruptions restored in Srikakulam affected habitations
- ✓ **100%** Power restored in Vizianagaram
- ✓ **99.45%** of PWS Schemes and **94.73%** of CPW restored
- ✓ **97.83 %** of Garbage Heap removed
- ✓ **100%** of affected Telecom sites restored
