> **Loss of lives and Injuries:**

- Total Cyclone Deaths - **11** (2 Vizianagaram & 9 Srikakulam)
- Total Injuries - **01** (1 male) Missing - **01** Fishermen

> **RWS**

- Out of **19 CPW** schemes affected, **1 CPW** schemes are yet to be restored.
- Out of **365 PWS** schemes affected, **363 restored** (104 with power and 259 by deploying 266 generators)
- **185** water tankers are supplying drinking water to **258** villages
- **97** Members deployed
- **52,50,000** Water Packets distributed

> **Electricity**

- **523** Teams with **7241** Members Deployed for restoration works.
 - **EPDCL** reported that cyclone has affected **1,802 villages**. (Srikakulam)
 - **Power restored in 1496 (83%) villages**
 - **Not yet restored 410 Villages**
 - **EPDCL** reported that cyclone has affected **358 villages**. (Vizinagaram)
 - **Power restored in all 358 villages**
 - Out of **10043 11KV poles** and **21437 LT poles** damaged,
 - **8324 11 KV Poles** and **16,788 LT poles have been rectified.**
- Approx. estimated damage Cost **Rs. 349** crores in Srikakulam District
